Prevention of Scarlet Fever

By referring to the circular about "predict flu prevention" and "Scarlet Fever", a thorough cleaning has been done in school. Parents are advised to monitor children's health condition closely, if suffering from fever, throat pain, coughing, runny nose, itchy skin rushes, vomiting, diarrhea or eye inflammation, students must stay home and seek early medical treatment.

The following measures are highly recommended:

- Students who suffer from fever, (oral temperature $\geq 37.5^{\circ}\text{C}$, ear temperature $\geq 38^{\circ}\text{C}$), sore throat or cough, they should seek medical care promptly. Please also notify the school and let your child **stay at home for rest** until recovery and should be watched for **at least two more days**, follow the medical advice on sick leave, whichever is applicable. (advised by Centre for Health Protection)
- Parents / Guardians must record the body temperature of your child and fill in form, and hand in to school for inspection.
- Cover nose and mouth when sneezing or coughing, and wash hands thoroughly afterwards.
- Dispose of soiled tissue paper properly in a lidded rubbish bin.
- Avoid sharing items e.g. eating utensils and towels.
